Privacy and Data Protection Issues



Related to COVID-19

1. Heightened Sensitivity to Data Protection Issues caused by
 - a) Increased volume of employees working remotely
 - b) Increased volume and potentially types of data needed offsite
 - c) Increased and targeted attacks focused on COVID-19

2. New and Evolving Privacy Issues caused by the need to collect information for health screening, monitoring and tracking to prevent exposures in the workplace and elsewhere



Cybersecurity Challenges and Solutions in the Remote Work Environment

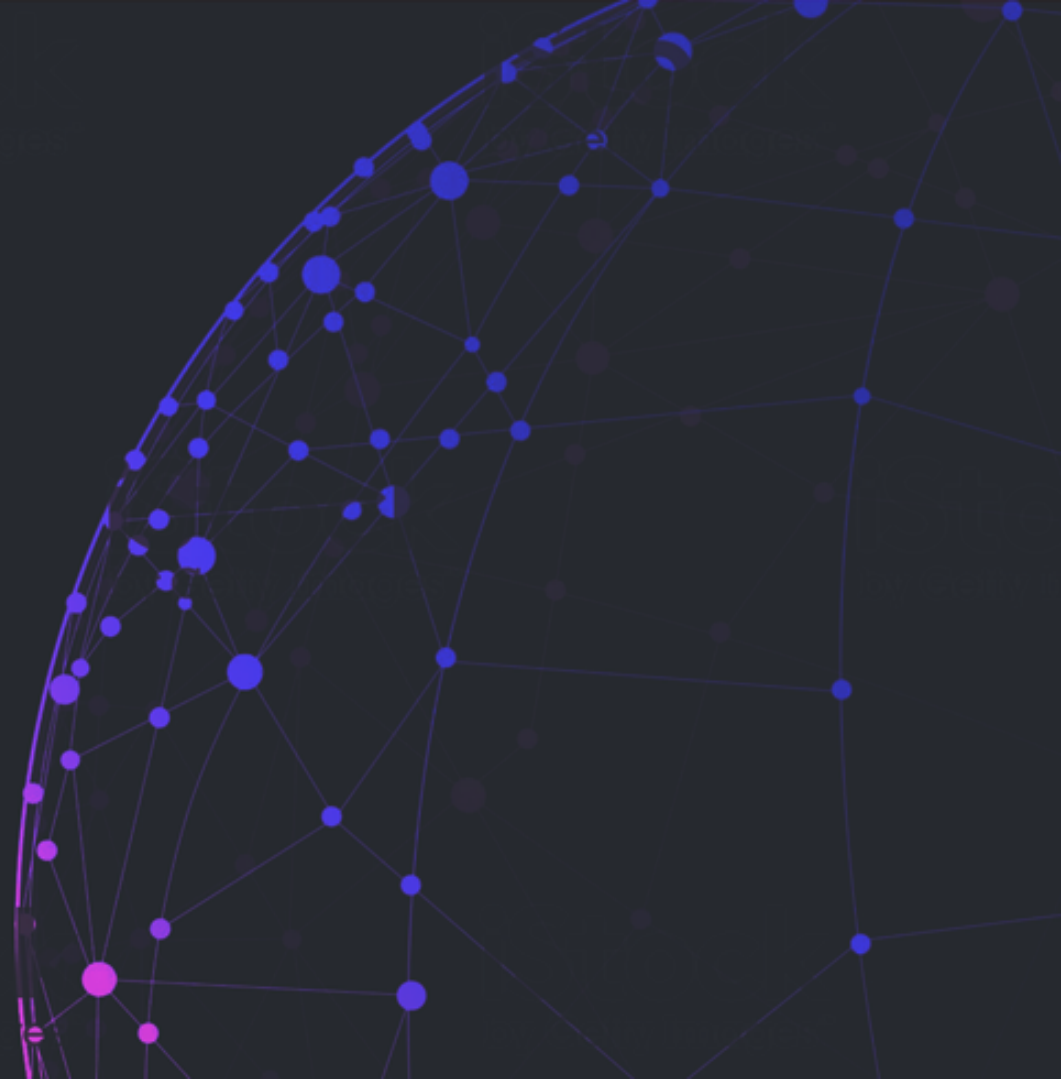
- a) Whether company issued or personal desktops and devices, do employees have the proper equipment to do their jobs consistent with the company's cybersecurity requirements?
- b) Are the company's facilities adequate to support the increased volume of remote access while maintaining cybersecurity?
- c) Is IT Support adequate to handle the increased traffic?
- d) Are policies and procedures adequate or should they be refreshed?
 - i. BYOD
 - ii. Remote Access
 - iii. Vendor Risk Management
- e) Privilege and Confidentiality issues



- a) Ability to collect health data through questionnaires, temperature readings or otherwise
- b) Tracking movements and contacts
 - i. Implementation of tracking technologies for COVID-19 Exposures
 - ii. Collection of tracking data by Government Authorities
- c) Ability to notify employees about health status of other employees or third parties
